christianity islam and judaism all feature ideas about heaven hell and afterlife and these concepts have evolved over time within these religions this work supplies a detailed and coherent understanding of the broad scope of spiritual thinking in the last 3 000 years within the abrahamic traditions heaven hell and the afterlife eternity in judaism christianity and islam provides an all encompassing examination of historic and contemporary perspectives on afterlife in western religions in these three volumes judaic christian and muslim scholars join forces providing an unprecedented review of their individual faith's traditions every significant issue and major theme is discussed no controversial topic is avoided from ancient doctrines to modern day outlooks of conservatives progressives and liberals in all three religions all are analyzed and presented here the framework of the volumes underscores how the ethics and concepts of eternity in the western action religions contrast with eastern religions that tend to be characterized as passive or withdrawal religions in their ethics and their notions of afterlife as absorption within universal spirit nirvana or nonexistence this work is well suited for undergraduate and graduate students general readers interested in religion and professional scholars particularly those in fields corollary to religious study

traditionally university students have gained access to world religions by reading primary texts discovering world religions at 24 frames per second takes students beyond the written page offering an exploration of the same religious traditions through the study of feature films the many definitions of religion are examined along with its various components including doctrine myth ethics ritual and symbol specific religious traditions including hinduism sikhism zoroastrianism buddhism confucianism daoism popular religion and shinto are examined biographical sketches of directors whose films tend to focus on a particular religious tradition are also included such as zhang yimou hayao miyazaki deepa mehta and akira kurosawa discovering world religions at 24 frames per second is unique in the area of religion and film studies in that it isn't just a collection of essays instead it provides the introductory student with the necessary

background information on the various religions before looking at how their ideas can be understood not through texts but through the cinematic medium to keep the conversation fresh most of the films used in the book were made within the last decade furthermore examples range from popular mainstream fare such as star wars and the lord of the rings trilogy to lesser known foreign films such as the wooden man s bride and the great yokai war several films with a cult like following are also discussed including fight club princess mononoke spirited away and jacob s ladder this book is also unique in that instead of drawing upon the judeo christian tradition it draws from eastern traditions

it s obvious that jesus fulfilled prophecies about the promised messiah or so the gospels make it seem but the real story is more complex and more compelling in hindsight we can see that jesus had help fulfilling prophecy the gospel writers skillfully manipulated prophecies carefully lifting them out of context creatively reinterpreting them even rewriting them to match what jesus would do in fulfilling them the evangelists also used the prophecies themselves to shape the very stories that show their fulfillment this book describes in detail how christian

authors helped Jesus fulfill prophecy studies of Greek oracles the Dead Sea Scrolls translations of the Hebrew Scriptures into Greek and Aramaic and the writings of Josephus explore the interpretive techniques that paved the way for the New Testament's manipulation of prophecy this book analyzes how the belief that Jesus fulfilled prophecy became an argument to justify a new notion the view that Christians had replaced Jews as God's chosen people an aggressive anti-Judaism is analyzed in chapters on patristic theologians such as Justin Martyr and Augustine who embedded it into the argument from prophecy the book concludes with an ethical argument for why Christians should retire the argument from prophecy

Globalization and high speed communication put twenty-first century people in contact with adherents to a wide variety of world religions but usually valuable knowledge of these other traditions is limited at best on the one hand religious stereotypes abound hampering a serious exploration of unfamiliar philosophies and practices on the other hand the popular idea that all religions lead to the same God or the same moral life fails to account for the distinctive origins and radically different teachings found across the world's many religions understanding world religions presents religion as a complex and intriguing matrix of history philosophy culture beliefs and practices Hexham believes that a certain degree of objectivity and critique is inherent in the study of religion and he guides readers in responsible ways of carrying this out of particular

importance is hexham s decision to explore african religions which have frequently been absent from major religion texts he surveys these in addition to varieties of hinduism buddhism judaism christianity and islam

divided into five components of teaching interreligious encounters theory design textual analysis practice and formation this volume guides both new teachers and seasoned scholars in addressing the sometimes challenging questions raised by contact between divergent faiths
